

# Thornton Conservation Commission

## Minutes from August 14, 2006 meeting 6:30 Thornton Town Hall

Attending were Sally Davis, Steve Shaughnessy and Timmee Whitmore

1. Approved June minutes with one change (change “Waterville” to “Waterville Valley”). Approved July minutes after making a change to the section on our mail. Specify who sent the mail and include a file # when available.
2. Sally plans on contacting Nancy Byerly (who updates Thornton and Campton in the “Talk of the Towns” section of the Record Enterprises). Sally will let her know that the Thornton Conservation Commission is meeting regularly and welcomes community members to join us.
3. Steve and Timmee have not yet been sworn in to their positions on the Thornton CC. We should stop by the Town Hall and take care of this ASAP.
4. Sally has changed her email and gave Steve and Timmee her new email address.
5. Mail
  - John March (Mountain Mapping) dated August 4, 2006
  - Regarding Franz Dubach and File #2006-00432
  - This is a response to the April 11, 2006 letter from the DES requesting more information for the permit application.
  - Everything looks in order and includes a detailed map, etc.
6. Sally brought in a copy of Thornton’s Master Plan 2003. It includes some maps from DRED (Dept. of Resource and Economic Development) and the North Country Council that may be useful for our NRI. The Master Plan is updated every 5-10 years.
7. Sally will ask Nancy Byerly (planning board chair) about another CC member filling in for Sally when she can’t make it to a planning board meeting.
8. We reviewed a pamphlet from the UNH Cooperative Extension about the NH Covert Project which puts on an annual workshop held each fall. The workshop is free, 3 ½ days, and is open to 25 enthusiastic landowners and other conservation-minded folks working along with a team of natural resource professionals. The applications are mailed in May.
