

Thornton Conservation Commission

Minutes from February 5, 2007 meeting 6:30 Thornton Town Hall

Attending were Sally Davis, Steve Shaughnessy and Timmee Whitmore

1. Minutes from January 8th meeting were accepted with 2 minor changes.
2. Timmee emailed Candy (during our meeting) the wording for our second Warrant Article – the one that will establish a Conservation Fund:

“To see if the town will vote to establish a conservation fund account as authorized by RSA 36-A:5, with the fund to be held by the municipal treasurer (RSA 41:29). The Board of Selectmen recommends this article. (Majority vote required).”

3. Mail

The meeting room was locked so we held our meeting in the entry of the town hall. However, we were not able to go thru any mail received in the last month since it was behind locked doors.

4. Reviewed Sally’s submission to the Town Report about the Thornton Conservation Commission and our activities. The report is due Wednesday 2/7.
5. We discussed an inquiry that was made a few years ago about donating land to the town. We are now educated enough to consider sending information to interested parties. Sally will ask if the donations are still being considered.
6. We agreed to purchase a copy of the book Natural Resource Inventories from UNH Coop Extension for the CC’s use. Steve owns a copy and Sally finds it quite informative.
7. Steve, Sally and Cathy will send (email) Timmee minutes from October and December. These 2 months are missing from our record since Timmee was absent. We’ll then email all of them to Beverly to be posted on the CC page on the Town’s website.
8. In our March meeting, we will get ourselves organized for the town meeting.
